




Where is Taft?



Taft CCF is Known for Quality Service and High Approval Ratings

Taft Community Correctional Facility (CCF) is a Type III Adult Detention Facility offering a viable solution to counties facing overcrowding problems after the Public Safety Realignment Act, AB 109, was enacted.

Taft's CCF is a modern, up-to-date facility that is well-equipped and ready with a full staff of sworn peace officers to accept inmates. The facility has consistently received approval ratings of 99 to 100 percent from the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR).

Taft CCF opened in 1991 and closed November 2011 when the CDCR ended its lease for inmate housing and returned inmates to counties.

Taft CCF provides a healthy environment in a dormitory-style setting for 512 inmates. Each dorm has approximately 64 beds, showers, restrooms and large open day rooms.



The facility houses longer-term inmates convicted of non-serious, non-violent and non-sexual (N3) crimes.

A tight budget is one of the best reasons for contracting with Taft CCF. Depending on your needs, the cost of housing inmates in Taft can be as low as \$61 per inmate per day.

Taft CCF provides on-site medical and dental services, educational and vocational services as well as life-skills classes to help reduce recidivism.
