NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Taft, California, will conduct a public hearing at a meeting to be held at 6:00 P.M., Tuesday, June 2, 2020, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at the City Council Chamber, 209 East Kern Street, Taft, California to consider the following:

Local Early Action Planning (LEAP) Grants Program – The City Council will conduct a public hearing for consideration to adopt a Resolution to submit a Local Early Action Planning (LEAP) Grants Program application to the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) to amend various chapters and sections of Title 6 of the Taft Municipal Code, which meets the Program Objective for local governments to prepare and adopt planning documents, process improvements that accelerate housing production and facilitate compliance in implementing the sixth cycle of the Regional Housing Need Assessment (RHNA).

A finding of exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act is recommended pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines.

All interested parties are invited to appear at this public hearing and present testimony concerning the items listed above. Documents related to these proposed actions are available for public inspection during regular business hours at the Planning Department at City Hall, located at 209 E. Kern Street, Taft, California, 93268.
